

# WaveView Quick Start Guide

## **Quick start steps**

#### Step 1

Login to the Wavestore server, and select your display configuration (e.g. 2x2) from the pull down list in the Main Screen. You can add a camera to the display area by using drag and drop from the Device Tree, or by double clicking on the name of a camera. Move between different camera layouts you've used by using the purple undo/redo arrow buttons on the toolbar.

### Step 2

Click on a camera display to select for control (the surround will highlight blue – see the lower right camera display above). Use the playback controls to Play/Pause, or click Stop to go back to Live View. The top right corner of the display will show the current status of the camera display (Live/Paused/Play).





#### Step 3

Click on a camera display to select for control (the surround will highlight blue – see the lower right camera display above). Use the playback controls to Play/Pause, or click Stop to go back to Live View. The top right corner of the display will show the current status of the camera display (Live/Paused/Play).







#### Step 4

To search footage, move your mouse to lower edge of the camera display, and the grey quick search bar will appear. Roll the mouse wheel in/out over the quick search bar to zoom in/out on the timeline (time increments will change). The grey time slider shows the current playback position. Click on a point on the timeline, and the time slider will move to that point.



#### Step 5

To save a still image, pause playback, move your mouse to the top right corner of the display, and click on the pencil icon.



#### Step 6

The Edit Dialog screen opens, with options for editing the still image (e.g. Crop/Blur), once you're ready click 'Save' to back-up the image.







#### Step 7

To backup footage from a single camera, use the flag icons above the camera display to set the start (Green) and end (Red) times for a backup. The quick search bar will show the time points that you've selected in Green and Red. Click on the blue Backup icon (next to the Green & Red flags) to open the Backup Dialog screen.



#### Step 8

If you're using the Wavestore WSB format for backup, check the 'include WaveView' option to include a copy of the software for playback. You can also select other backup formats (e.g. AVI/WMV), so the backup file can be played back with Windows Media Player. Click on 'Start' to create the backup. A confirmation message will appear once the backup is complete.
